- Rapid re-housing and homelessness prevention for veteran families
- Transitional housing for homeless veterans and
- Permanent supportive housing for veterans and veteran families

MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAMS

For more than three decades, Community Hope has been addressing the needs of individuals and families affected by mental illness.

Our programs provide a safe haven with professional staff supporting the recovery of adults struggling with bipolar disorder, depression, schizophrenia and other serious mental illnesses.

Transitional Housing

- Our residential recovery homes are staffed 24 hours a day to serve individuals requiring around-the-clock support, daily living assistance, and other rehabilitative services following a State psychiatric hospital stay.
- Daily supervised apartments provide individuals with counseling, medication monitoring, and other rehabilitative services each day as they transition from 24-hour residences.

Community Support Services Program

Community Support Services is a mental health rehabilitation and support service that assists individuals to attain the skills necessary to achieve their wellness and recovery goals. Case management services include linkage to mental health and other services as identified by the individual's rehabilitation plan. Services can be provided in Community Hope's Affordable Housing Program or the individual's own home.

Affordable Housing Program

We offer affordable housing to individuals with mental illness to enhance their ability to live independently whether they are receiving rehabilitative services from Community Hope or another mental health agency.



HOPE FOR VETERANS® PROGRAMS

For Homeless and At-Risk Veterans

Community Hope is the leading charity housing homeless veterans and at-risk veteran families in New Jersey and Eastern Pennsylvania through the following range of services.

Supportive Services for Veteran Families

SSVF is a homeless prevention program providing temporary financial assistance and case management services to help low-income veteran families remain in their homes and to rapidly re-house homeless veterans. Transitional Housing Programs

Our 95-bed transitional housing program provides safe shelter, support and employment services, and access to VA healthcare for homeless veterans. Located on the Lyons VA campus and operated by our private charity, veterans can reside here for up to two years. We also operate an 8-bed program in Bergen County. Valley Brook Village Permanent Housing

With on-site employment and support services, Valley Brook Village offers subsidized rental apartments to ensure affordable housing and services to low-income veterans.
